Itinerary

DAY ONE

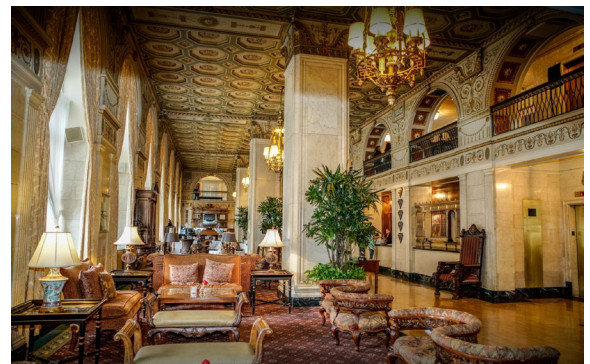
- Board your luxury motor coach in Lexington, Kentucky and depart for your first tour, The **Woodford Reserve Distillery** and the historic barrelhouse. Private tasting to follow.
- Our second visit features the historic Spanish mission style **Four Roses Distillery**. Private tasting follows and all guests gifted with their signature tasting glass.
- Accommodations are at the historic and luxurious **Brown Hotel**, your home for the following three days of cultural pleasure. After checking into your Club Level room, perhaps enjoy a cocktail surrounded by quintessential southern charm before dinner.
- This evening includes an arranged welcome dinner on property at the Brown Hotel's signature restaurant, Hot Brown. Spend the evening at leisure to explore the hotel's fabulous atmosphere or to stroll downtown Louisville.

DAY TWO

- This morning offers one of two optional excursions:
 - Option One:** Visit and tour of **Churchill Downs and Museum**, featuring an interpretation of the equestrian experience and the history of this iconic American institution
 - Option Two:** Bourbon Bootcamp experience at **Evan Williams**. Limited to 6 participants, this event provides a hands-on, interactive experience in a real working distillery with the Evan Williams Artisanal Distillery Team. From mash to barrel, guests will heat the copper column pot stills, distill grain from local farmers, share tastes of new make, and fill a barrel with hand-crafted American Whiskey. Sign that day's barrel before it heads off to their aging house in Bardstown. (Participants must be able to lift 50 lbs).
- Late morning takes us to **Stitzel Distillery** for a Mixology Class. Start your experience with a complimentary welcome cocktail before enjoying a tour of the historic Stitzel-Weller Distillery. Then visit one of their tasting rooms where you will create your very own festive cocktail using mixology techniques and hand-crafted syrups designed by Bar Manager, Greg Hojnacki.
- A group Lunch is included downtown
- Next visit Whiskey Row for an exclusive tour of the **Old Forester Distillery** and enjoy a guided tasting of Old Forester Single Barrel, 1910 Old Fine Whisky. This evening is at your leisure on Whiskey Row to enjoy dinner at one of the many unique restaurants in the area.

DAY THREE

- This morning we depart for the **Heaven Hill** Bourbon Heritage Center for their Whiskey Connoisseur Experience. This fascinating experience provides history and insights of the unique characteristics of their premium or limited release American Whiskeys, focusing on the color, aroma, taste and finish.
- We then travel to the Bardstown Distillery, **Makers Mark** for a tour and tasting, followed by an included lunch at "Star Hill Provisions".
- Next, it's on to **Rabbit Hole Distillery** for a tour of their operation and product. With a dram of Cavehill in hand, tour their facility before arriving at the awe-inspiring Overlook lounge with a tasting of their award-winning whiskeys, Cavehill, Heigold, and Boxergrail. Of particular note is their unique London Dry Gin aged in rye whiskey casks.
- Located in the historic Fort Nelson building on Main Street, **Michter's Distillery** is home to a legendary historic distillation system. Here you will learn about the extra steps in Michter's whiskey production process to pursue the greatest American whiskey. Following the tour, taste five different Michter's expressions before heading up to the bar, where your visit will conclude with a cocktail demonstration and a small cocktail sample.
- Your motorcoach will provide transfer to the Louisville airport at the end of the day, or for those who arrived in Lexington by car, there will be an optional motorcoach transfer return to your parked vehicle.
