

ITINERARY

DAY 1: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 13 • DEPART FOR ITALY

Depart on independent flights to Rome, Italy. (Please do not purchase flights until the tour is confirmed to operate. Corporate Travel will notify you in writing.)

DAY 2: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 14 • ORVIETO

Arrive in Rome, where you will be greeted by Teresa Tomeo, Kelly Wahlquist and your Italian Tour Director. Group transfer to the hill-top city of Orvieto. Celebrate Mass. After hotel check-in and time to freshen up, enjoy a festive Welcome Dinner. Overnight in Orvieto.

DAY 3: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 15 • ORVIETO

Breakfast at the hotel followed by a walking tour of the beautiful city. DAY 4 MONDAY, OCTOBER 16 • ORVIETO | ASSISI

After breakfast, we will travel to Assisi for the day. Mass in lower Assisi at the Basilica of St. Mary of Angels with tour to follow. Group lunch in Assisi followed by a tour of Upper Assisi. Return to Orvieto for late dinner on your own. Overnight in Orvieto.

DAY 5: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 17 • SAN GIMIGNANO | SIENA

After breakfast, check out of hotel and board the bus for San Gimignano, known as the town of Fine Towers. Free time to stroll and shop in this Umbrian town, famous for its ceramics, leather goods and local food and wine products. Lunch on your own. Continue to Siena for Mass and hotel check in. Overnight in Siena.

DAY 6: WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 18 • FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel before departing for the city of Florence. Celebrate Mass at the Duomo followed by a quick walk through the open-aired museum of Renaissance art and architecture. After a traditional Tuscan lunch, embark on walking tour of Florence, including the famous statue of Michelangelo's David. Free time for shopping, or a visit to the Ponte Vecchio for that special piece of fine Italian gold jewelry. Enjoy a special tasting of the local products of Tuscany before returning to Siena for dinner on your own and overnight.

DAY 7: THURSDAY, OCTOBER 19 • SIENA | ROME

After lunch on your own, depart for the eternal city of Rome. Hotel check in, followed by a special lecture of the Sistine Chapel. Dinner on your own and overnight in Rome.

DAY 8: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 20 • ROME

Early Breakfast or boxed breakfast at hotel, before departing for Mass at St. Peter's Basilica. Tour the Vatican Museums, including the magnificent Sistine Chapel. 
