ITINERARY

Day 1: Thursday, November 2, 2023 | Depart USA

Depart the USA on overnight flights to Rome, Italy.

Day 2: Friday, November 3, 2023 | Rome | Orvieto 📥



Arrive in Rome, meet your Italian escort, and depart by private motorcoach for Orvieto. Check into hotel before the welcome dinner. Overnight in Orvieto.

Day 3: Saturday, November 4, 2023 | Orvieto 💻



This morning, visit Orvieto, where we will celebrate Mass at Duomo (Cathedral), where the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena is preserved. Tour the Duomo and the quaint Umbrian city. We will drive to a local winery located in the beautiful Umbrian countryside just outside Orvieto. You will visit the estate, learn about the production process and the varieties of local grapes and finally enjoy a wine tasting. Return to Orvieto for dinner on your own and overnight.

Day 4: Sunday, November 5, 2023 | Viterbo | Orvieto 👤 🍔





Today, travel to Viterbo, its name coming from the Latin "Vetus urbs," that means old city. Nowadays, the main city in Northern Lazio is a lively center with bustling shopping malls, offices, bars and restaurants. Day 5: Monday, November 6, 2023 | Orvieto | Narni | Todi |





After breakfast, head to Narni. Founded by the ancient Umbrians, Narni eventually became a Roman colony. Narni, which is not widely known, is one of the most beautiful towns of Umbria. Narni even inspired the title of C.S. Lewis's famous novel series, "The Chronicles of Narnia," when he came across the Italian town of Narnia in a classical atlas he used as a child. Recently, thanks to the opening of its ancient underground cisterns and excavations, it has started to gain a new popularity, attracting people with mysterious tales and unsolved questions. To have a walk throughout Narni will enable you to go back in time, feeling in the city's very stones its long and many-layered history. Continue to Todi. The historic center of Todi reflects the wealth and prosperity of this lovely town in the Middle Ages. With our tour, you will explore the city center focusing on the famous central square closed on one side by the Cathedral of Saint Mary and on the other side by the 13th-14th century government buildings. Jacopone from Todi, poet, and Franciscan friar but furthermore the author of Stabat Mater Dolorosa, one of the greatest Latin hymns of all time, was born there. You will visit Saint Fortunato church which preserves his tomb. Just a few steps out of the city center you will see the Renaissance architecture of Santa Maria Della Consolazione, built to preserve a 15th-century image that performed a miracle that attracted a flood of pilgrims to the town. Twenty years ago, Todi, this little town perched on a hill in the Tiber Valley in Italy, was celebrated as the world's most livable town, a modern paradise. That was the conclusion reached after a lengthy study by a team from the University of Kentucky. Continue to Assisi for dinner and overnight.

Day 6: Tuesday, November 7, 2023 | Assisi | Greccio | Assisi 👤



Celebrate Mass this morning at the Basilica San Francesco followed by adoration and a tour of the Basilica, including prayer at the tomb of Saint Francis. Walk to the Basilica of Santa Chiara for a guided tour and to pray at the tomb of St. Clare. After lunch on own, travel to Greccio. We will visit the Eremo (hermitage) in Greccio, the city where St. Francis got the idea of creating a Nativity Scene, a "creche." Return to Assisi for overnight.

Day 7: Wednesday, November 8, 2023 | Assisi | Tarquinia | Cerveteri|Rome 💻 🍔

After breakfast we will travel to Tarquinia. Visit the medieval center, the National Archaeological Museum housed in the Gothic, Renaissance Palazzo Vitelleschi, in the heart of the town center, it displays a wide range of artifacts (pottery, bronzes, jewelry, sarcophagi) dating from the Iron Age (10th Century B.C.) to the Romanization of the Ancient Etruria (1st Century B.C.). Among the

masterpieces: the terracotta high relief from the Ara della Regina Temple depicting two winged horses and the original fresco paintings from four tombs: Triclinium, Chariots, Olympic Games, Ship. Lunch in a local restaurant. Continue to Cerveteri. The Necropolis of Banditaccia at Cerveteri, UNESCO site since 2004 along with the Necropolis of Monterozzi at Tarquinia, represents the grandest example of funerary architecture of the Etruscan culture and one of the most important archaeological sites in the Mediterranean. This ancient cemetery stretches for hundreds of hectares on a tufa plateau. The tombs were excavated in the tufa rock, faithfully replicating the plan and furnishings of habitations of the same period. Following a chronological itinerary, visitors can follow the evolution of Etruscan funerary architecture over more than six centuries. Dinner on your own. Overnight in Rome.

Day 8: Thursday, November 9, 2023 | Christian Rome 🔎 📥



This afternoon, depart for a sightseeing tour with focus on Christian Rome. St. Mary Major, one of the oldest shrines dedicated to the Blessed Virgin, a shrine that contains a relic from the manger of the infant Jesus. We visit the Basilica of St. John Lateran. It is here that St. Francis persuaded Pope Innocent III to give permission to begin the Franciscan Order. The night before, the Pope had seen John Lateran. The next day, when Francis appeared before Pope Innocent, His Paul under its main altar. After lunch enjoy some free time before returning to

This morning, celebrate Mass at St. Peter's and take a guided tour of the basilica. Tour the Vatican Museums, ending with a visit to the Sistine Chapel, where you will view some of the most inspiring works of art, including Michelangelo's magnificent fresco of the Last Judgment. Lunch and the remainder of the afternoon to explore Rome. Overnight in Rome.

Day 10: Saturday, November 11, 2023 | Ancient Rome | Walking Tour 👱

This morning, take part in a walking tour in historic Rome, including: The Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona and more. After lunch on own, tour Ancient Rome, including the Colosseum (inside visit), Capitol Hill, the Vittorio Emmanuel Monument (wedding cake), the Roman Forum, and Circus Maximus Overnight in Rome.

Day 11: Sunday, November 12, 2023 | Depart for the USA

This morning check-out of the hotel and depart for the Rome Airport for your flights to the USA.
