Day 1: Tuesday, August 15, 2023 | Depart the USA

Day 2: Wednesday, August 16, 2023 | Arrive in Scotland



Arrive in Scotland and transfer independently to your hotel. Board your coach for pre-dinner visit a local distillery for a tasting session. After your tour, you will depart for a Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.

Day 3: Thursday, August 17, 2023 | Drumlanrig Castle | Edinburgh Military Tattoo

This morning meet your coach and head off to Drumlanrig Castle. While touring this historic site, enjoy a private lunch prepared specially for the group by the castle. This evening, attend the Edinburgh Military Tattoo. The Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo is Scotland's biggest, bestselling outdoor spectacle. The venue itself is situated in the most popular part of the city, on the beautiful Edinburgh Castle's doorstep, high above the skyline. Dinner will be at your leisure. Overnight in Edinburgh.

Day 4: Friday, August 18, 2023 | Festival Day

Day 6: Sunday, August 20, 2023 | Half Day Excursion - Edinburgh



Meet your coach and local guide and embark on a sightseeing tour of Edinburgh during which you will appreciate the contrast between the 18th century Georgian "New Town" with its wide, tree lined streets and elegant squares and the medieval "Old Town". The Royal Mile is the backbone of the old quarter, running from the Palace of Holyroodhouse to Edinburgh Castle. Visit The High Kirk of Edinburgh, St. Giles' Cathedral, regarded as the mother church of Presbyterianism. The Cathedral was officially consecrated by the Bishop of St. Andrews in 1243, however its four massive central pillars date back to approximately 1120. Enjoy a visit to the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the official residence in Scotland of His Majesty The King. Positioned at the foot of the Royal Mile against the spectacular backdrop of Arthur's Seat, this fine baroque palace is closely associated with Scotland's rich history. The Palace is perhaps best known as the home of Mary, Queen of Scots, and as the setting for many of the dramatic episodes in her turbulent reign. Today the State Apartments are used regularly by The King and other members of the Royal Family for State ceremonies and official entertaining. Enjoy lunch as a group. Later this afternoon enjoy a Three Pub Tour with your group leader (any visit to Scotland would not be complete without a bar experience). The evening concludes with a group dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.

Day 7: Monday, August 21, 2023 | Half Day Excursion - Royal Yacht Britannia



Morning at leisure in Edinburgh. This afternoon transfer to Leith to enjoy a private visit to the Royal Yacht Britannia, the late Queen's former floating Royal residence. She was home to the Royal Family for over 40 years and sailed over one million miles around the world. Discover what life was like on board - start at the Bridge, continue to the State Apartments, Crew's Quarters and finish at the Engine Room. Follow in the footsteps of world leaders such as Winston Churchill, Nelson Mandela and Rajiv Gandhi. A personal guide will give guests a unique insight into the history of the Royal Yacht and how the Royal Family and crew lived and worked on board. A glass of champagne will finish the tour. Enjoy a Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Edinburgh.

Day 8: Tuesday, August 22, 2023 | Return to the USA

Checkout of your hotel and return to the US on independent flights.
